

What to do on the day of Arafah 9th Zul Hijjah

The 9th day of Zul Hijjah is known as Youmul Arafah (The Day of Recognition) for various reasons. It is regarded to be the best day of the year and one in which many virtues are combined.

The following are established practices from the Hadith which every Muslim should endeavour to fulfil on this great day.

Fasting on the day of Arafah - The fast of this day has great significance and is highly recommended. Nabi # said "I have hope in Allah Ta'ala that the fast of Arafah will be an atonement for the (minor) sins of the past and the forthcoming year."

Seek forgiveness and sincere repentance - Nabi said, "There is no day in which Allah sets free more souls from the fire of hell than on the day of Arafah. On this day Allah draws close to the earth and by way of exhibiting His Pride remarks to the angels, 'What is the desire of these (servants of mine)?"

Acceptance of Dua - This is a day for abundant dua. It is advisable to set aside time in this day for dua so dua can be made in earnest. Try to make as many duas as possible by remembering family, friends, the Ummah and humanity at large. Nabi # said, "The best dua is the dua on the Day of Arafah, and the best of what I and the prophets before me have said, is



Malaysians effective boycott of KFC stores

Due to months of economic boycotts linked to the Israel-Palestine war, over 100 branches of the fast-food franchise KFC have been "temporarily closed" in Malaysia.

In response, QSR Brands; the owner and operator of KFC across Malaysia, Brunei, Singapore, and Cambodia; has taken to temporarily closing outlets in order to manage losses. A number of 108 stores have by this time ceased operations. The Kelantan state has been hit the worst, affecting up to 21 outlets within the province alone.

Similarly, there have also been reports of Starbucks and McDonalds closures across the Muslim-majority nation Malaysia. These chains have reported a slump in business due to the USA's stance on the war in Gaza.



New 'Home Affairs on Wheels' initiative launches across South Africa

A total of 100 trucks were launched into service, and these mobile offices will process applications for smart IDs, passports, and birth, marriage, and death certificates on site. The fleet is expected to be distributed across the nation.

"This new fleet of mobile Home Affairs offices won't be moving constantly around the provinces. They will be available in a village or town at a particular time so that people can know when to go there," Ramaphosa said at the opening. "We don't want to make it easier. We want to make it faster and we want to make it cheaper."...READ MORE

New Khayelitsha police station boasts advanced technology to tackle crime

The station was provided 15 new vehicles fitted with Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) technology. This system provides tremendous help in detecting whether vehicles are registered or licensed.

"We have started rolling out these new devices throughout the country to trace criminals and also deal decisively with car hijackings and vehicle theft criminals," National Commissioner of the South African Police Service, General Fannie Masemola, said. "We have a number of the devices in each province and we hope to get more to assist and enhance our crime fighting initiatives."

ZIKR FOR THESE 10 DAYS

Hazrat ibn Abbas reports that Rasulullah said: "There are no days in the year wherein the worship of Allah Ta'ala is greater (in reward) and more beloved to Him than the first ten days of Zul Hijjah. Therefore increase the recitation of Tasbeeh, Tahmeed, Takbeer and Tahleel.


HAZRAT UTHMAN BIN MAZ'OON **%**

Name: Uthman bin Maz'oon Al Jumahi Al Qurashi

Title: Abu Saaib

Uthman bin Maz'oon was one of the early companions. He was from the tribe of Quraysh, specifically from the clan of Jumah. Uthman bin Maz'oon was among the earliest reverts to Islam and played a significant role in the early Muslim community.

Like many early Muslims, Uthman bin Maz'oon faced persecution and hardship in Makkah due to his adherence to Islam. He endured social ostracism, economic difficulty, and physical torture along with other early Muslims.



THE TAKBEER OF THE DAYS OF TASHREEQ

اَللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ اَللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ ، لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَاللَّهُ أَكْبَرُ وَلِلَّهِ الْحَمْدُ

RULING:

The recitation of the above Takbeer is compulsory upon every male and female immediately after every Fard Salah.

DAYS OF TAKBEER:

Commences: After the Fajr Salah of the Day of Arafah (09 Zul Hijjah)

Terminates: After the Asr Salah of the last day of Tashreeq (13 Zul Hiiiah)

METHOD:

For males, it should be recited audibly once immediately after making Salam. Females should recite it softly.

Hint: Ladies may consider sticking a little reminder at the place where they perform Salah to help them remember the recitation of the Takbeer.

Islamic Guidance On What To Do Upon The Birth Of A Child

The arrival of a new-born brings great joy, delight and fulfilment to the parents and family. With the arrival of the newborn problems and tribulations are forgotten, and the parents' focus is now directed to their bundle of joy. However, coupled with this joy, the coming to being of a child is a tremendous responsibility upon the shoulders of the parents.

Islam has prescribed certain practices on this occasion, which are beneficial, and if carried out correctly, will have a positive effect on the child. Practices which are not established and which could bear negative repercussions for the child, should be avoided.



AFTER THE CHILD IS BORN

If possible, and health permitting, the child should be given a ghusl (bath). Thereafter, the Azan should be called into the child's right ear and Iqamat in the left ear. The Azan may be called by the child's father or an adult Muslim.

By calling out the Azan and Iqamat into the new-born's ears, the name of Allah Ta'ala and Nabi Muhammad # reaches the depths of the child's heart. The seed of Iman and faith is embedded in the child. Azan also repels shaytan.

It is preferable to recite the following dua after the Azan and Iqamat:

For a boy recite:

أَللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أُعِيذُهُ بِكَ وَ ذُرِّ يَّتَهُ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّحِيْم

Transliteration: Allahumma inni ueezuhu bika wa zurriyyatahu minash shaytaanir rajeem.

For a girl recite:

ٱلَّلَهُٰمَّ إِنِّي أُعِيذُهَا بِكَ وَ ذُرَّ يَّتَهَا مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّحِيْم

BE MINDFUL OF THOSE AROUND YOU

Being mindful of those around you involves cultivating awareness, empathy, and consideration for others' thoughts, feelings, and needs.

The Noble Qur'an emphasises kindness towards parents, relatives, orphans, etc. Furthermore, one's duty of kindness and awareness goes beyond those closely related to everyone who one comes in touch with.

Being kind and empathetic entails:

- Paying close attention to what others are saying without interrupting or judging. Show genuine interest in their perspective and validate their feelings.
- Acknowledging others' feelings and demonstrate empathy by offering support or assistance when needed.
- Being mindful of your body language, facial expressions, and tone of voice, as these cues can convey your attentiveness and respect for others.
- Being patient and understanding, especially when others are expressing themselves or dealing with challenges. Avoid rushing or dismissing their concerns.
- Offering support, encouragement, and kindness whenever possible.



Q&A

Is it permissible to make Qurbani during the night?

It is preferable to slaughter during the day, It is however permissible at night, if there is sufficient lighting.

How should a person make up for Qurbani if he did not perform it?

If Qurbani is Wajib, the obligation must be executed. If Qurbani was not offered due to any reason, then it is Wajib to give in Sadaqah (charity) the price of the Qurbani animal or the unslaughtered (live) animal itself to the poor (if the animal was purchased and not slaughtered).

What is the wisdom of Qurbani?



Sacrificing an animal is an act that symbolizes this philosophy. Qurbani calls for the slaughter of one's egoistic traits such as hatred, jealousy, pride, base desires, lust, greed, animosity, love for the world and other such maladies of the heart.

Is it permissible to do Qurbani before Eid Salah in rural areas and farms?

Yes, if the Qurbani is done at a place where Eid Salah is not permitted like a rural area or farm, it will be allowed to do Qurbani once the Fajr Salah time sets in.

I will be a Musafir on the days of Qurbani i.e. 10th, 11th and 12th of Zul Hijjah. Will Qurbani be compulsory upon me?

Qurbani is not compulsory on a Musafir (traveller). However, if a Musafir has the financial means and is able to do Qurbani, then this would be greatly rewarding and praiseworthy.

Is it permissible for a husband to purchase and sacrifice a Qurbani animal on behalf of his wife?

Yes, a man may purchase and sacrifice an animal for his wife from his wealth, with her consent, for the validity of her Qurbani.

When should Qurbani be performed?

The time for Qurbani commences after the Eid Salah on 10 Zul Hijjah and ends at the setting of the sun on 12 Zul Hijjah. It is better to make Qurbani on the first day, but permitted on the 2nd and 3rd day.

Is it permissible to appoint a proxy to perform one's Qurbani?

Qurbani will be discharged when done by a proxy. The proxy may be an organisation or an individual. His intention will suffice.

SUNNATS OF EID


- 1. Wake up early, Miswak, bath, wear one's best clothes, Itr (perfume)
- 2. Not to eat before the Eid Salah
- 3. Recite the Takbir of Tashreeq loudly while going to the Eid Salah
- Perform Eid Salah at the Eid Gah & go by foot
- 5. Return from the Eid Salah on a different route to the one taken
- 6. Eat from one's sacrificial animal before partaking of any other food

THE "FAST" OF EID-UL-ADHA

It is Mustahab (preferable) for the person making Qurbani to abstain from eating anything on the Day of Eid from the morning till his animal is slaughtered. It is preferred to partake of the Qurbani meat first, before eating anything else from the Ourbani animal.

NB. This is a Mustahab (optional and rewarding) practice - there is no compulsion. However, we should all endeavour to practice and reap the benefit.
